## OFFENDER REGISTRATION SUPPLEMENT to the PSI – K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 22-4901 et seq.

### Offender is ordered to register for \_\_\_\_\_ years for:

- An offense not otherwise required, as provided by the Kansas Offender Registration Act, K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 22-4902(a)(5)
- Sexual Battery when no party involved is less than 18 years of age (no registration duration stated in K.S.A. 22-4906)
- Aggravated Human Trafficking when the victim is not less than 18 years of age (no registration duration stated in K.S.A. 22-4906)

### Offender must register for 15 YEARS after the date of parole, discharge or release, whichever date is most recent, or, if offender is not confined, 15 YEARS from the date of conviction due to conviction of any of the following crimes:

- Capital Murder - formerly K.S.A. 21-3439
- Murder in the First Degree – formerly K.S.A. 21-3401
- Murder in the Second Degree – formerly K.S.A. 21-3402
- Voluntary Manslaughter – formerly K.S.A. 21-3403
- Involuntary Manslaughter – formerly K.S.A. 21-3404
- Criminal Restraint – formerly K.S.A. 21-3424 (except by parent, and only when victim is less than 18 years of age)
- Any act determined beyond a reasonable doubt to have been sexually motivated AND the act did not involve non-forcible sexual conduct between a victim at least 14 and offender no more than 4 years older than victim – K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 22-4902(a)(15)
- Any conviction of a person felony with court finding on the record that such felony was committed with a **DEADLY WEAPON**
- Manufacture** or attempted manufacture of any controlled substance – formerly K.S.A. 21-36a03
- Possession of precursors** with intent to manufacture any controlled substance – formerly K.S.A. 21-36a09(a), 21-36a10(a)(1), (a)(2)
- Cultivation, Distribution, Possession** with intent to distribute opiates, opium or narcotic drugs or any stimulant in K.S.A. 65-4107(d)(1), (d)(3), or (f)(1) – formerly K.S.A. 21-36a05(a)(1) **ONLY**
- Any attempt, conspiracy or criminal solicitation of an offense defined in this section
- Any of the following crimes when one of the parties is less than 18 years of age:
  - Sexual Battery - formerly K.S.A. 21-3517
  - Adultery - formerly K.S.A. 21-3507
  - Patronizing a Prostitute – formerly K.S.A. 21-3515
  - Lewd and Lascivious Behavior – formerly K.S.A. 21-3508

### Offender must register for 25 YEARS after the date of parole, discharge or release, whichever date is most recent, or, if offender is not confined, 25 YEARS from the date of conviction due to conviction of any of the following crimes:

- Indecent Solicitation of a Child – formerly K.S.A. 21-3510
- Electronic Solicitation – formerly K.S.A. 21-3523
- Agg. Incest – formerly K.S.A. 21-3603
- Indecent Liberties With a Child – formerly K.S.A. 21-3503
- Unlawful Sexual Relations – formerly K.S.A. 21-3520
- Agg. Sexual Battery – formerly K.S.A. 21-3518
- Sexual Exploitation of a Child – formerly K.S.A. 21-3516, if the victim is at least 14 years of age but less than 18 years of age
- Promoting Prostitution – formerly K.S.A. 21-3513, if the prostitute is at least 14 years of age but less than 18 years of age
- Criminal Sodomy - as formerly defined in K.S.A. 21-3505(a)(1) when one of the parties involved is less than 18 years of age
- Any attempt, conspiracy or criminal solicitation of an offense defined in this section

### Offender is subject to LIFETIME registration due to any of the following:

- 2<sup>nd</sup> or Subsequent conviction of an offense requiring registration
- Conviction of any of the following crimes:
  - Rape – formerly K.S.A. 21-3502
  - Agg. Kidnapping – formerly K.S.A. 21-3421
  - Kidnapping – formerly K.S.A. 21-3420
  - Agg. Criminal Sodomy – formerly K.S.A. 21-3506
  - Criminal Sodomy – formerly K.S.A. 21-3505(a)(2) or (a)(3)
  - Agg. Indecent Liberties With a Child – formerly K.S.A. 21-3504
  - Agg. Indecent Solicitation of a Child – formerly K.S.A. 21-3511
  - Agg. Human Trafficking– formerly K.S.A. 21-3447, if the victim is less than 18 years of age
  - Sexual Exploitation of a Child – formerly K.S.A. 21-3516, if the victim is less than 14 years of age
  - Promoting Prostitution – formerly K.S.A. 21-3513, if the prostitute is less than 14 years of age
  - Any attempt, conspiracy or criminal solicitation of an offense defined in this section
