2022 JOURNAL ENTRY OF PROBATION VIOLATION (PVJE) EXPLAINER

This highlighted document is intended to explain the changes to the forms that will go into effect on July 1, 2022. These changes are due in part to the passage of new legislation, which will go into effect on that date, while some changes are the result of feedback received from those who use the forms.

Please note that unless specified, the statutory (K.S.A.) references are intended to direct the user to the most current version of the statute. If a K.S.A. 2022 Supp. is referenced, this law is already in effect as of July 1, even though the statute itself has not yet been published.

• The year in the title has been changed to 2022 and is to be used for any probation violation hearing occurring on or after July 1, 2022 for any probationer. This contrasts with the use of the PSI and JE, which are tied to the date of offense.
