

2023 JOURNAL ENTRY OF JUDGMENT (JE) EXPLAINER

This **highlighted** document is intended to explain the changes to the forms that will go into effect on July 1, 2023. These changes are due in part to the passage of new legislation which will go into effect on that date, while some changes are the result of feedback received from those who use the forms.

Please note that unless specified, the statutory (K.S.A.) references are intended to direct the user to the most current version of the statute. If a K.S.A. 2023 Supp. is referenced, this law is already in effect as of July 1, even though the statute itself has not yet been published.

PAGE 1

- The date in the title has been changed to be used for all crimes *committed* on July 1, 2023-June 30, 2024. (Subsequent pages as well).

PAGE 2

- Language added to indicate the new enhancement sentence of Criminal Discharge of Firearm at dwelling, structure, or vehicle and the corresponding enhancements 60 months or 120 months (K.S.A. 21-6804(aa)(1)). See Special Rule 52.

PAGE 3

- Additional language is added to clarify that the community corrections fee is to be collected by community corrections.

OFFENDER SPECIAL RULE SUPPLEMENT PAGE 1

- Four Special Rules are added to reflect the statutory changes in 2023:
- 49: Manufacture of Fentanyl-Related Substance – presumptive prison and double the maximum penalty. K.S.A. 21-6805(h).
- 50: Distribution of Controlled Substance, packaging attractive to minor – presumptive prison and double the maximum penalty. K.S.A. 21-6805(i).
- 51: Criminal Possession of Firearm by a Convicted Felon- presumptive prison and consecutive to any other sentence. K.S.A.21-6804(z).
- 52: Criminal Discharge of Firearm at dwelling, structure, or vehicle- presumptive prison plus 60 months with person present 14 and over; 120 months with person present under 14. K.S.A. 21-6804 (aa)(1).

- Statutory subsection changed to reflect current statute under K.S.A. 22-4902(c)(19).
